Modern Slavery Statement

Barwick Bathroom Distribution LLP are committed to our practices that combat and ensure there is no modern slavery or human trafficking within our business or supply chain.

Modern slavery is a crime and a violation of fundamental human rights. It takes various forms, such as slavery, servitude, forced and compulsory labour and human trafficking, all of which have in common the deprivation of a person's liberty by another in order to exploit them for personal or commercial gain.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending January 2019.

As a leading distributor in the UK of quality bathroom brands, we source our products from a number of worldwide suppliers within our industry.

We have a zero tolerance approach to slavery and human trafficking and we expect that our suppliers will hold their own suppliers to the same high standards. We insist that all those within our business and supply chain comply with our values and as part of this process:-

- All existing suppliers in our product portfolio have signed our Supplier Agreement which includes a clause to ensure there are no Modern Slavery Practices within their Supply Chain.
- All new suppliers will sign our Supplier Agreement.
- We encourage the reporting of any concerns and the protection of whistle blowers.

Our Modern Slavery Statement demonstrates our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure slavery and human trafficking is not taking place anywhere within our supply chains.

Should any instances come to light in which a particular supplier is involved in modern slavery or human trafficking, we will terminate any dealings with them with immediate effect.
